Clothing: In all events competitors must wear at least vest and shorts (or equivalent clothing) which are clean and so designed and worn as not to be objectionable, event if wet. Competitors must wear the vest of their first claim affiliated club or their County, Territorial or National vest.

Equipment: Athletes may provide their own equipment provided it is submitted for checking by the Technical Manager. Only Starting Blocks provided by the venue may be used.

Acceptance letter, timetable and directions will be sent out approximately two weeks prior to the Championships.

Entry Standards: There are no entry standards, but England Athletics reserves the right to restrict entries.

ENTRY FEES £10 per event. Cheques and postal orders made payable to England Athletics Ltd in UK sterling – **Do not send cash.** **Free Entry** – to defending championships (same event and age group)

PLEASE do not send a stamped addressed envelope.

AGE GROUPS: Under 20 Competitors must be under 20 on 31st December 2007
 Under 17 Competitors must be under 17 on 31st August 2007
 Under 15 Competitors must be under 15 on 31st August 2007

Athletes may compete outside their age group as defined in UK: Athletics Rules (Rule 107) but cannot compete in the same event in two different age groups.
