



In fantastic conditions, Southampton's U11 squad performed superbly in their third Wessex league quad kids match of the season on a sun kissed Winchester track. The young athletes won 4 of the 8 individual events, had 3 boys in the top 6 in the individual all round competition, an astonishing 5 of the top 6 in the girls individual all round competition and won both girls & boys team events. 46 personal best performances were recorded including at least 1 from every single young athlete

The girls event was won by the ultras consistent Cerys Ralph with a points total of 221 points, accumulating at least 50 points in each of the 4 events. 2nd was Olivia Hollos with 209 points including 72 for a sub 2 minute 600m. 4th was Georgia O'Dell and joint 5th were Niamh Dunlop and Poppy Wright who was making her debut for the club and remarkably is still in school year 4.

Faye Hooton also made an impressive debut to come 20th followed by Isabelle Bennett in 23rd & Katy Butler in 24th. Jennifer Pimley came 40th and was another making her Southampton AC debut.

In a high quality boys event, George Rosam was 2nd with 247 points including a scorching 11.1 secs to win the 75m. Dan Head was 3rd with 242 points throwing the howler over 30m. Jack Sherborne was just a point behind Dan in 4th place followed by Josh Gunstone who recorded 3 pb's to come home 8th. Jack Higgins was 14th including a sub 2 minute 600m and debutant Charlie Carter-Banks was 19th. Harry Jones again making his debut came home 23rd, Patrick Fisher was 25th and Jack Renshaw was 29th.
