



3 medals for the U11's

Southampton Athletic Club's U11 squad performed tremendously well in the Hampshire quadkids championships at Portsmouth on the 2nd May winning 3 of the 12 medals available. It was a fantastic turnout of 15 young athletes showing the future is extremely bright for the club.

The competition was split into quadkid events for both year 4 & 5 boys and girls with the usual format of 4 events of the 75m, 600m, vortex throw & long jump.

In the year 5 girls, Cerys Ralph made a fine Southampton A C debut to take overall 3rd place including a win in the 75m sprint. Olivia Hollos was 8th overall, Eli-rose Francis 15th, Georgia O'Dell 18th & Isabelle Bennett 20th.

In the year 4 boys, Jack Renshaw also marked his track & field debut for the club with an overall 3rd place finish including a fine win in the 600m. Patrick Fisher was just behind him in overall 4th place followed by Jack Kelley in 6th place & Travis Macdonald-Coak in 8th.
